

ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT

Identify, plan, and achieve your career and academic goals with support from Academic Advising Services. Academic Advising Services provides students guidance and support in choosing a program of study that best aligns with their future aspirations.

Advisors assist students with academic planning and goal setting, to ensure a clear pathway to graduation. When obstacles occur, academic advisors can connect you to student support services and other campus resources to get you back on track.

New-to-college students can seek academic advisement by following our college's Enrollment Steps. As part of our Enrollment Steps, new students complete Coyote Kickoff which is a self-paced online pre-advisement-workshop, followed by an initial advising appointment with an academic advisor. Advisors will review program requirements and class placement, then recommend your first-semester classes to enroll in.

If you are not a first-time college student, you are encouraged to make a virtual appointment with an academic advisor aligned with your program of study. Students must be currently admitted to the college in order to make a scheduled appointment with an advisor via the college's Advisement website. It is recommended that all prior credit has officially been transferred and evaluated before making an appointment.
